Note.- Shri. Parth Rajendra Mahajan who has applied for the 'Legislation Internship Program' from the Five Years Law Course and was selected for the Programme. However, he has communicated telephonically, that he is unable to attend the said Programme. Therefore, next eligible students is selected and the revised Order is issued therefor.

2. The applications were invited through "AICTE Internship Portal" from students studying in,-

- (1) 5 Years Law Course (Students studying in 4th and 5th Year) - 6 students;
- (2) 3 Years Law Course (Students studying in 2nd and 3rd Year) - 4 students; and
- (3) LL.M. Course (Students studying in 1st and 2nd Year) - 2 students.

3. Twelve students were selected on the basis of the following criteria:-

- (1) In order to give an opportunity to students of different Law Colleges/ Universities in the State of Maharashtra 12 students from 12 different Colleges / Universities.
- (2) One student from one Law College is selected.
- (3) Selection is based on MH-CET/ CLAT Marks.
- (4) Students having knowledge of Marathi language with ability to read and write have been given preference.
- (5) From 5 Years Law Course - 6 students are selected.
- (6) From 3 Years Law Course - 4 students are selected.
- (7) From LL.M. Course - 2 students are selected.
